Adam’s Camp Englewood, CO	Adam’s Camp Sibling Camp This grant funds the summer camp experience designed to honor sibling’s role in families of children with disabilities.	\$22,140
Baylor Scott & White McLane Children’s Hospital Temple, TX	Angel Eyes for Tiny Texas & Their Families This grant funds the purchase of eight new cameras for the hospital NICU. The use of cameras reduces the anxiety for parents when they cannot be by their infant’s bedside, increase communication with the medical team. and increase parental bonding.	\$9,600
Children’s Cancer Fund (CCFNM) Albuquerque, NM	Family Support Helps cover transportation costs for families with children diagnosed with and treated for cancer in New Mexico.	\$20,000
Children’s Hospital Colorado Aurora, CO	To Improve Colorectal & Urogenital Care Around The World This grant provides financial support for surgeons training in Greece for highly specialized urogenital/colorectal procedures at the hospital’s International Center for Colorectal and Urogenital Care.	\$15,000
Driscolls Children’s Hospital Corpus Christi, TX	Seeing Hearts Where They Are This grant funds four portable ultrasound devices to diagnose and follow children with congenital heart disease.	\$24,002
Full Circle Health Boise, ID	Pediatric Residency Training and Reach Out and Read Program This grant funds the purchase of child and newborn simulation mannequins for Pediatrics and Family Medicine training books for families to share the lifelong benefits that result from reading aloud their children every day.	\$20,000



Heroes For Children Dallas & Houston, TX	Assistance for Families of Children with Cancer This grant funds financial and social assistance to families with children 0-22 years of age battling cancer.	\$25,000*
Heroe's Path Palliative Care Albuquerque, NM	Respite, Education, & Psychosocial Support This grant will help provide respite care, education, and psychosocial support to families and their children who have medically complex conditions.	\$20,000**
Love Fund for Children Inc. Kansas City, MO	Life Essentials Request - Medical & Therapeutic Technologies This grant funds supplies, equipment, and services for children with illness, whose needs are beyond the funding ability of their families and support networks.	\$20,000
Malileh Free Clinic Millcreek, UT	2023 Healthy Families Support Program This grant fund medical equipment and supplies to this clinic serving an underinsured population	\$10,000
RMHC Denver, CO	Infant Nutrition This grant funds the purchase of eight breast pumps for mothers to use while guests at the Ronald McDonald House, providing an efficient way to collect milk for their newborns and infants to meet their babies' nutritional needs while they are undergoing care at area hospitals.	\$17,600
Shriner's Hospital Salt Lake City, UT	Pediatric Orthotics & Prosthetic Services This grant funds custom-designed braces (orthotics) and artificial limbs (prothesis) for children attending this specialty clinic from the Rocky Mountain West.	\$20,000
Team Jack Atkinson, NE	Tower Banking for Power5 Initiative This grant funds the purchase of a storage chamber and centrifuge equipment for tumor banking and research into causes and treatments of Medulloblastoma, which accounts for 20% of all Pediatric brain tumors between 3-8 years of age.	\$11,000



Texas Children's Hospital Houston Houston, TX	Improving Outcomes in Neonate through Video Laryngoscopy This grant will fund the purchase of video Laryngoscope and accessories for the NICU.	\$29,196
The Children's Place Kansas City, MO	The Play Place on Wheels This grant funds the costs to complete the retrofitting of a therapy bus, providing individual therapy for pre-kindergarten age children on location, elimination traditional barriers to mental health services including time, cost, transportation, and scheduling.	\$32,300
The Family Conservancy Kansas City, MO	Outpatient Mental Health Therapy for Children This grant funds outpatient mental health therapy, meeting the needs of vulnerable populations: young children, domestic violence victims, and parents of young children.	\$17,000
The WillStrong Cancer Foundation Highlands Ranch, CO	Computational Analysis of Childhood Leukemia Emergence & Treatment Resistance This grant funds the purchase of computer equipment, software, and data storage for the computational biologist at Children's Hospital, CO Anschutz Medical Camps Research Center.	\$22,500
UCHealth Northern Colorado Foundation Fort Collins, CO	Safe-Kids Larimer County-Car Seat Education and Distribution Program This grant funds car seat distribution to qualifying families to continue reducing child injuries and fatalities due to motor vehicle crashes.	\$13,400
