**Feed the Hungry** We kicked off our District feed the hungry program on the last Tuesday of every month last fall with extraordinary success. We distribute food, clothing, toiletries, hand knitted hats and sweaters, sleeping bags and new underwear and socks to the underserved and homeless of New York City. The number of chapters participating continues to grow. Those served are extremely grateful for everything we provide, love, prayers, and sustenance.



**Social Services** Last fall chapters collected new and used children's books for donation to local classrooms in need, and we collected 14,065 books! This spring chapters collected 9,210 items for the kids' weekend backpack programs who participate in their schools' free breakfast and lunch programs but don't have food on the weekend. These drives bring the faithful together with a common goal of doing good work and helping those in need. Assisting those in need is the heart of Philoptochos, we continue to assist with local services, a loving hand and financial assistance at a difficult time.

**St. Michael's Home** As St. Michael's builds its new state of the art continuum of care facility in Uniondale, Long Island it meets the ever-increasing needs of our elderly. The Archdiocesan District Philoptochos chapters support this ministry of the Archdiocese wholeheartedly. On Thursday May 4<sup>th</sup> and Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup> we had hard hat tours for Philoptochos members at the new facility.

**Beacons of Hope Seminarian Scholarship Fund** We are thrilled to continue to support our seminarians in their journey to the priesthood. We make contributions to their education and living expenses. Many individuals and several chapters have donated and held fundraisers and embraced our New Beacons of Hope Scholarship fund.

**Biennial Conference** May 20<sup>th</sup> is our **Biennial Conference** where we will be reporting on the last two years of activity, elections for the District Board and training sessions/workshops on our

new Domestic Violence initiative and chapter board transitions in addition to our favorite topic-membership!
